To this end, we now have an enthusiastic group of experienced leaders who are willing to run selected drama workshops on Saturday mornings on a rota basis through term times. We also plan to look at getting more professionally run workshops in from time to time, as has been

We believe that as Patchwork Drama is a village organization we are ideally looking for a village based Coordinator, though would welcome enquiries from all PDG members and Patchwork member parents.

Written by our very own Matt Lim, this is a world premiere for Pattingham!




